DESIGN OBJECTIVES

ENHANCEMENT OF STREET AND BUILDINGS INTERACTIONS
Buildings like Kencom and Re-Insurance have grills around them that have been replaced with green spaces to enhance their interaction with the street.

RESPONSE TO ELEVATED WALKWAY ALONG NAIROBI CINEMA
The elevated walkway along Nairobi Cinema and my development accessible roof level are at the same level to allow easy access to and from my development.

SPILLING OVER THE ACTIVITIES INTO THE STREET
Java restaurant has been extended into my development to enhance the surrounding buildings connection to my development.

SHADING OF THE STREET FROM WESTERN SUN
Thick tree vegetation has been planted along the boundary wall separating the walk and the private car park to shade the street from western sun.

DECONGESTING OTHER STREETS AND PROVIDING A PERMANENT SELLING SPACE FOR MAASAI MARKET TRADERS.
A permanent selling place has been provided for hawkers who sell in the streets of Nairobi congesting them. Maasai traders who sell at the Judiciary Parking have also been allocated a permanent selling space within the sector
