



This is an affordable housing development that can be adapted with different formations in a range of sites. The honeycomb-shaped structure has an interchangeable nature; the ability to change location or position whilst keeping costs consistent by being manufactured by machinery offsite. As affordable housing models are spread across London, it is important to use an original design to promote a new architectural language in the city that inspires people to live and design more comfortable and sustainable houses. The structures allow the habitant to grow thier own fresh produce, reduciung reliance on shops and supermarkets where supply is heavily influenced by external factors. This structure easily adapts to the nature of the UK economy, alongside the shortage of affordable housing.
