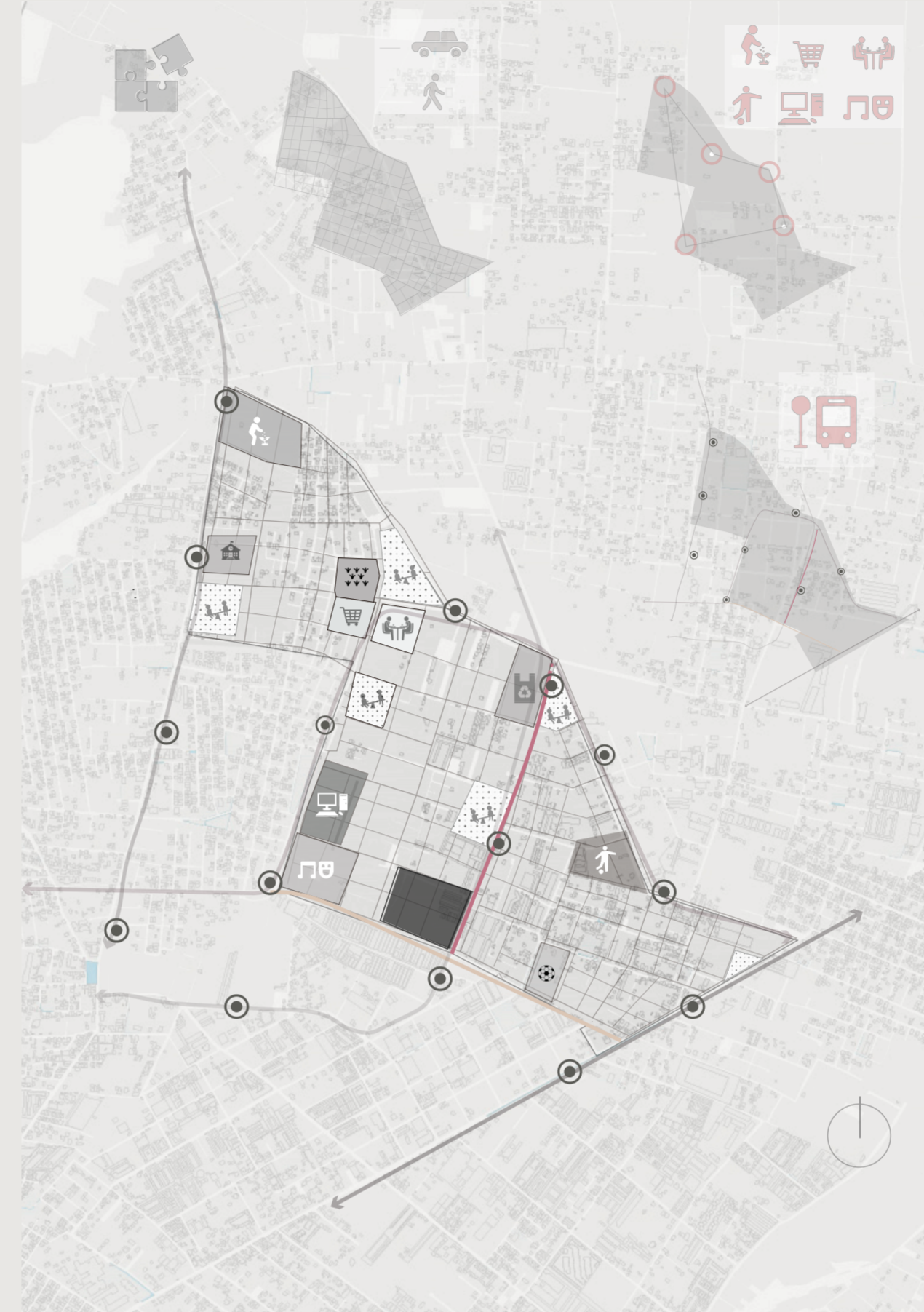
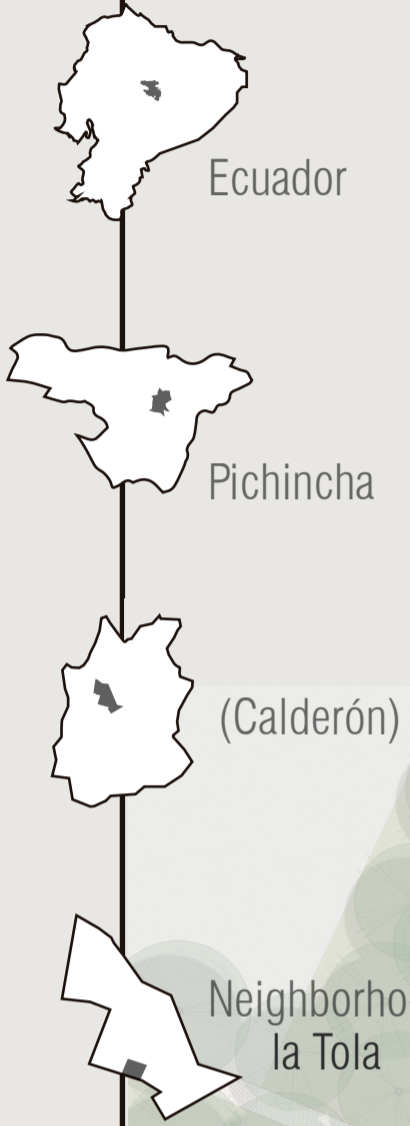


INCLUSIVE SOCIAL HOUSING

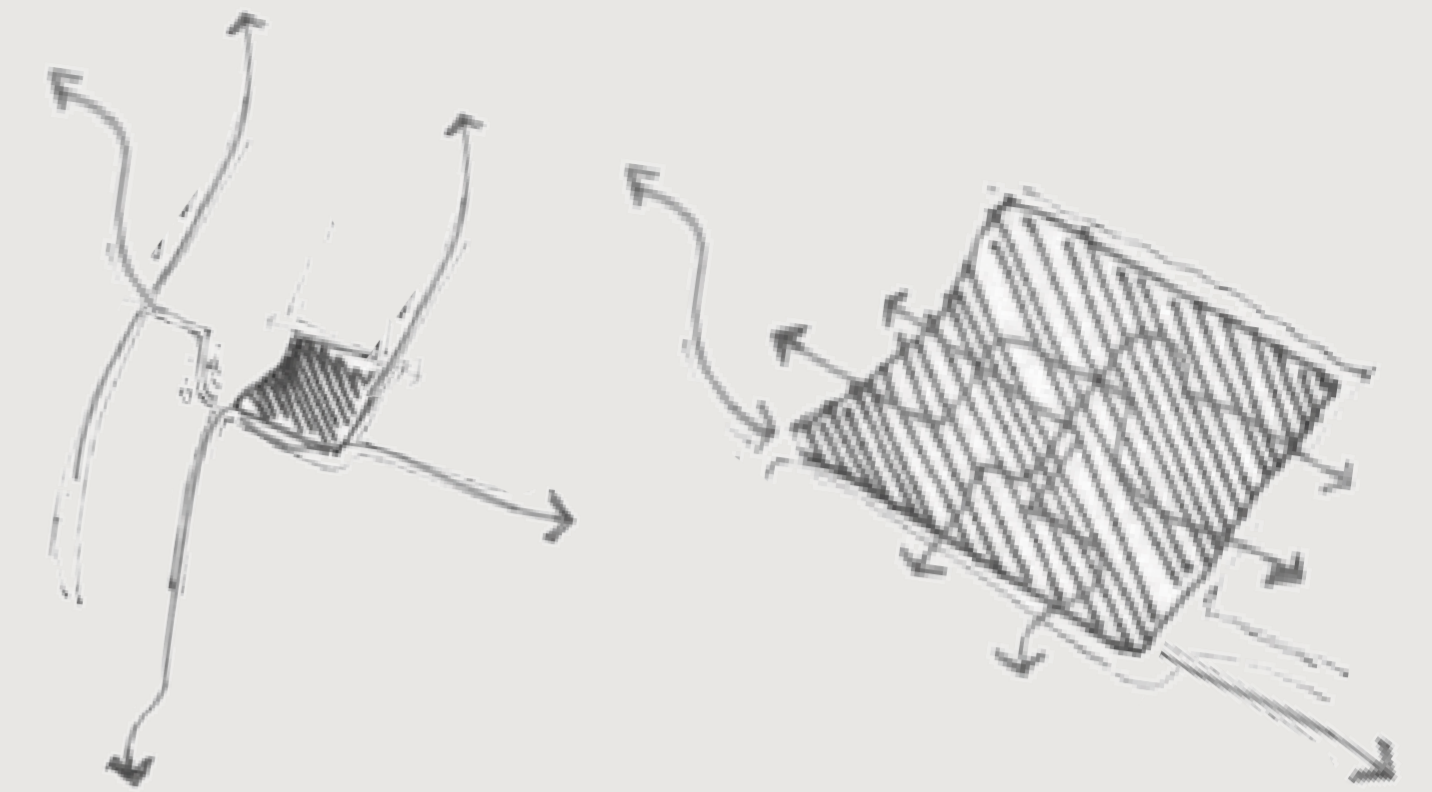
CALDERÓN - Neighborhood La Tola

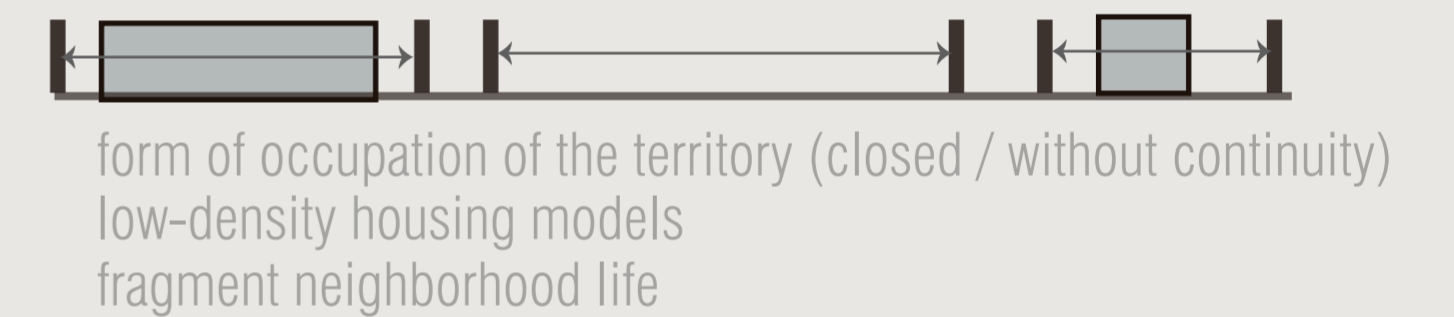
