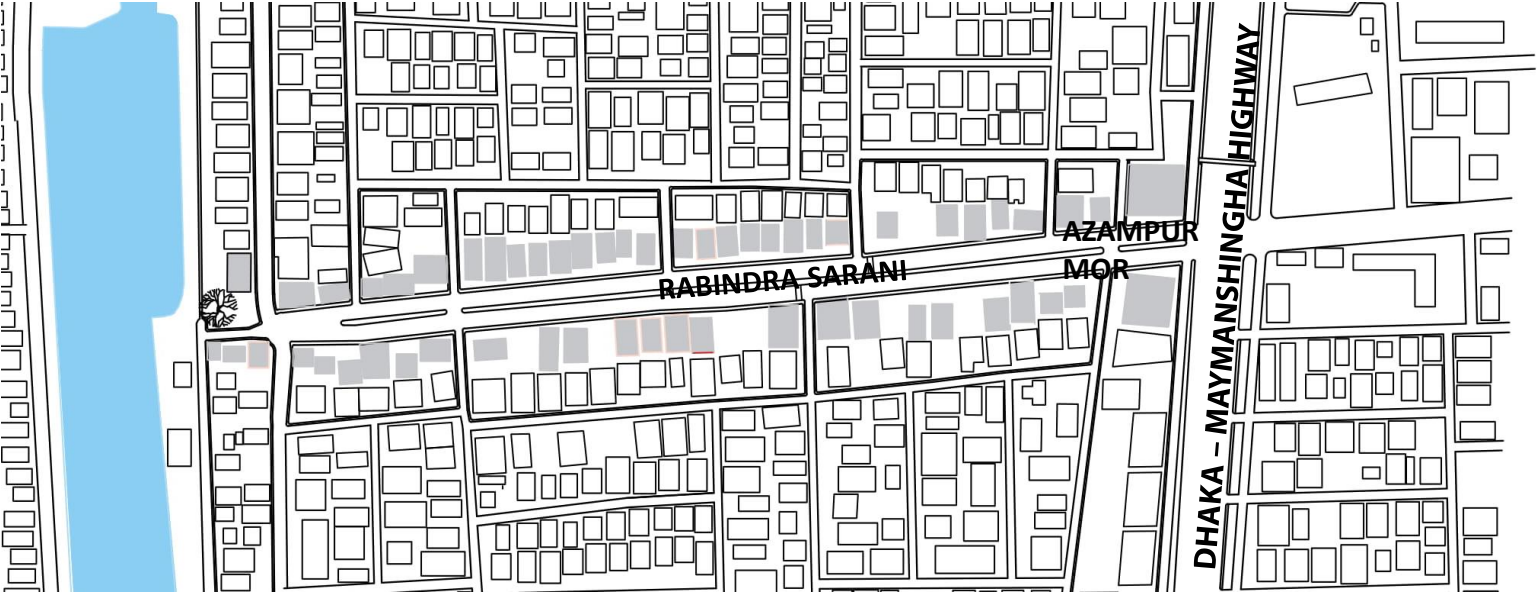

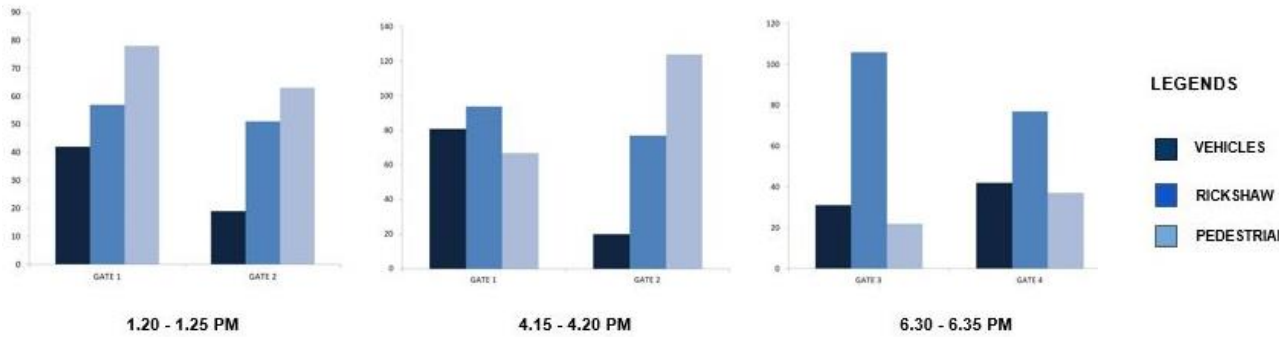
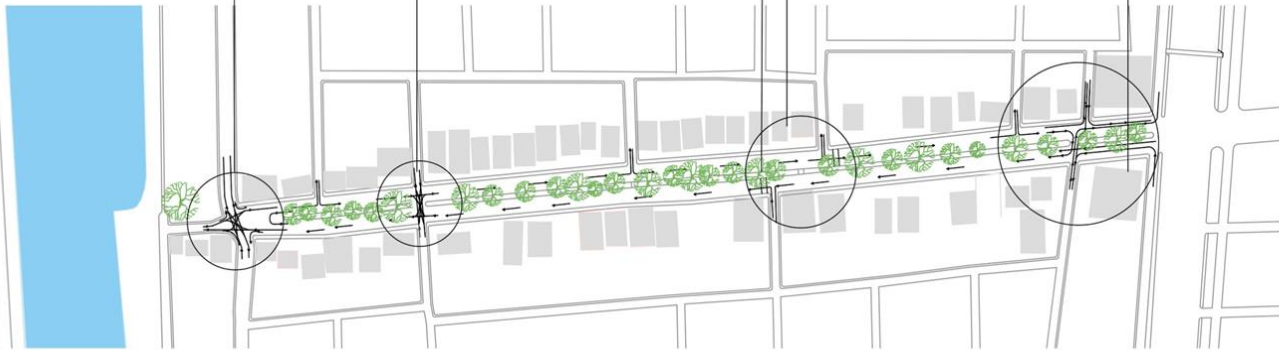
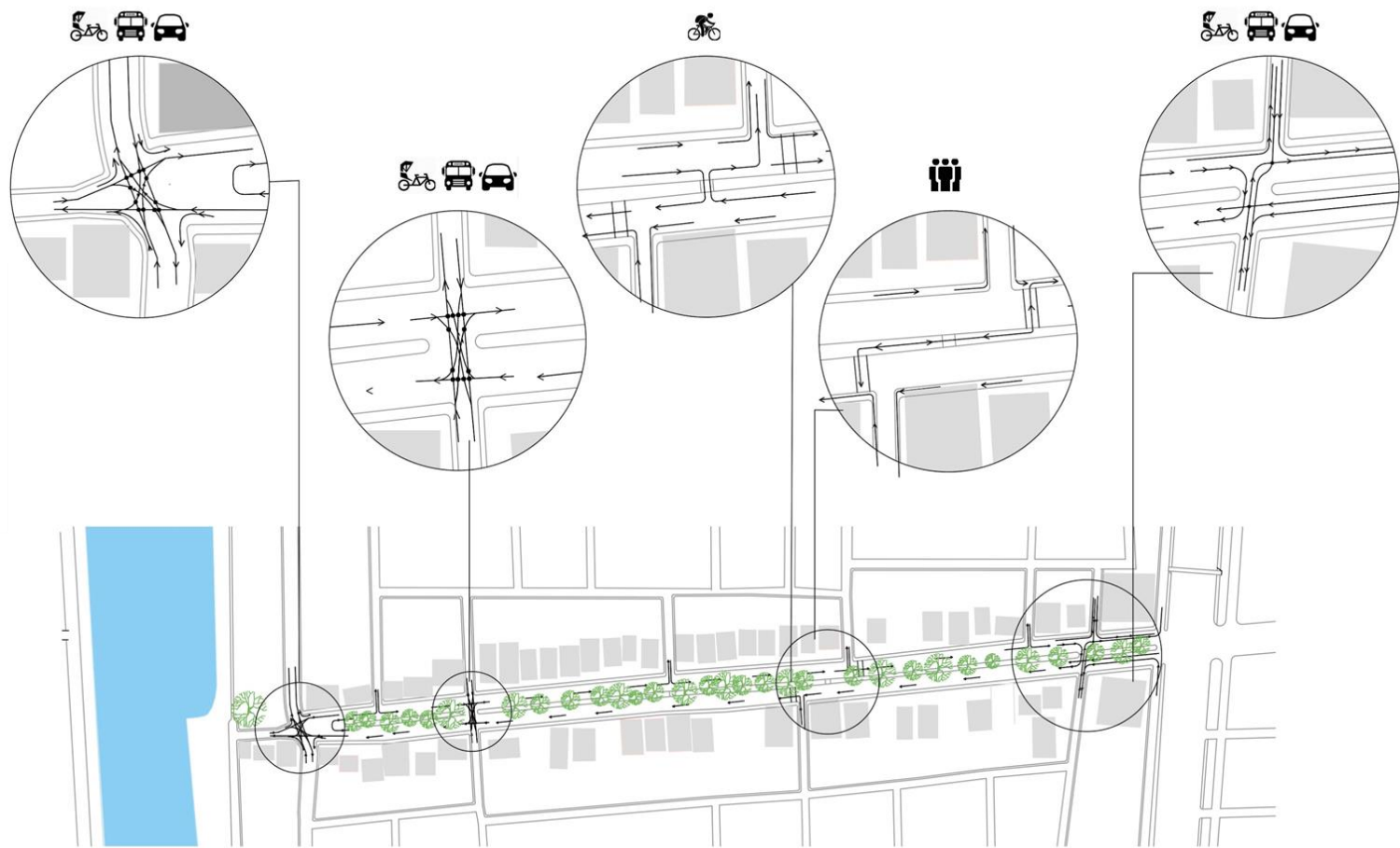
EXISTING STREET SECTION

- Heavy Traffic Congestion at nodal point
- Tempo Stand at nodal point
- Parking at the entrance of the road
- Boundary wall of the lake creates visual barrier
- No recreational activity
- No waste bin, water facility, seating and public toilet
- Lack of security
- The street becomes dead after 7 pm
- Lack of sale of vendors.

GOALS

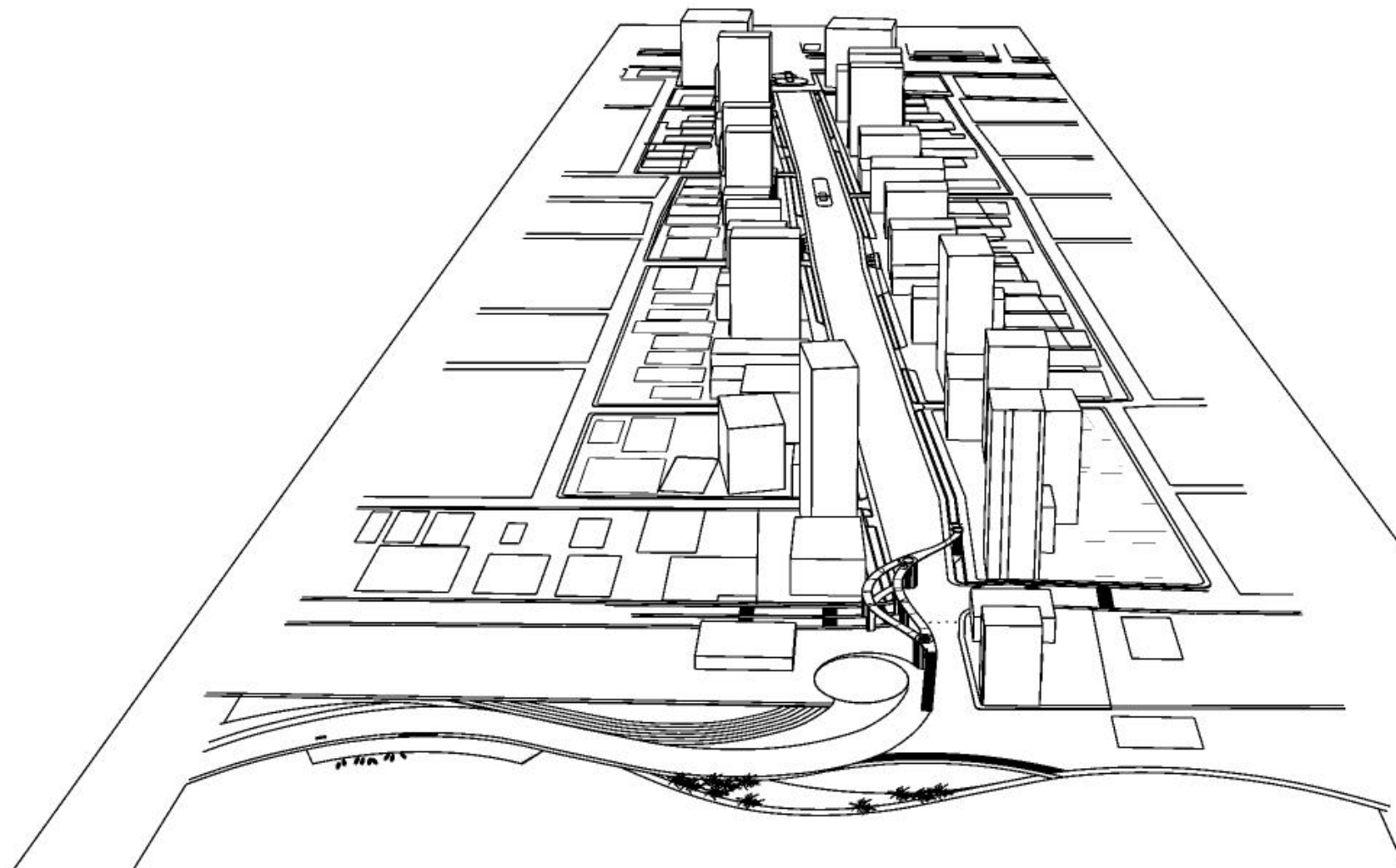
- Encouraging walking

- Creating a breathing space for the city dwellers.

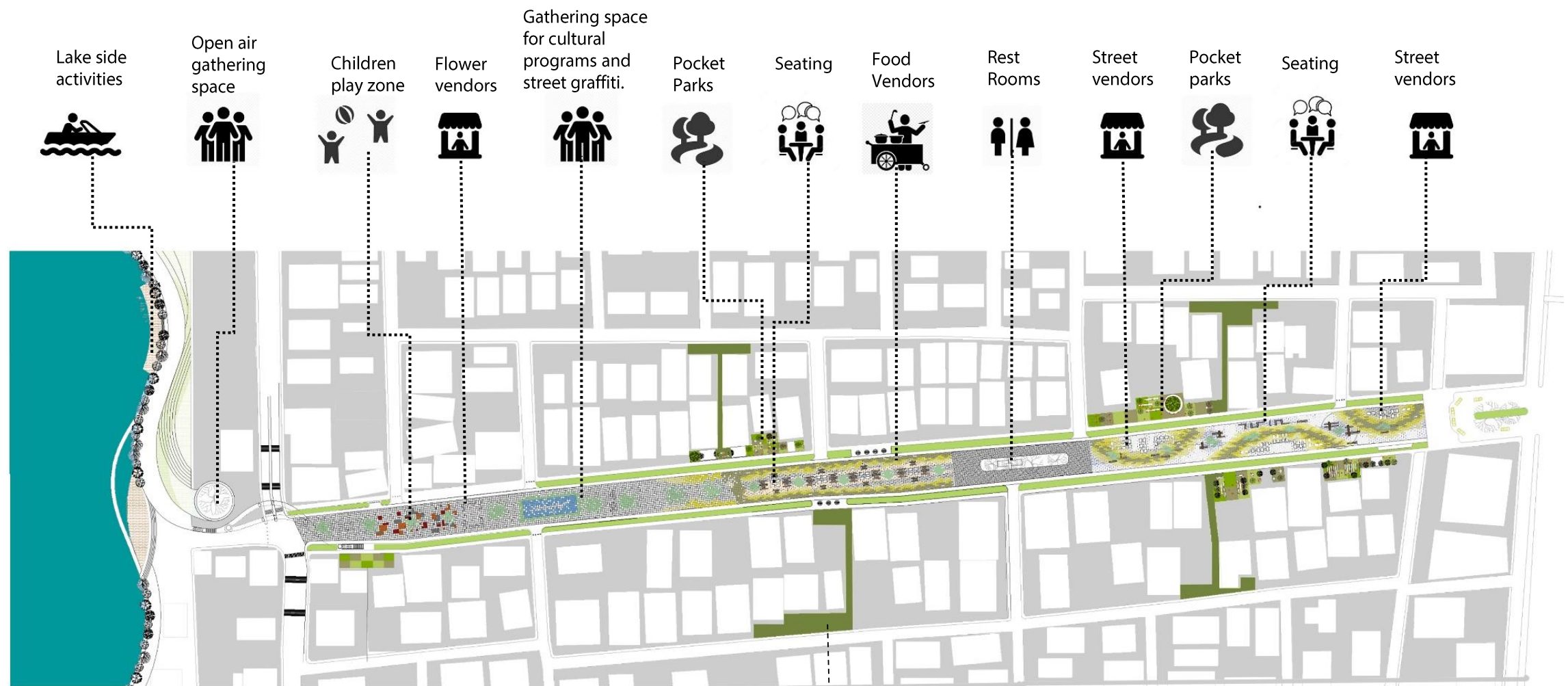

POLICIES

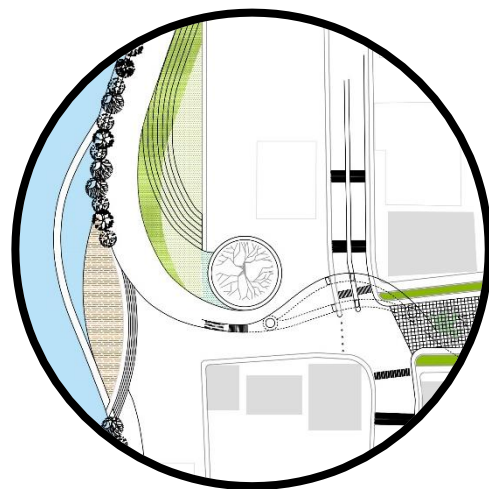
- Declared shopping street

- Controlled vehicular access during emergency



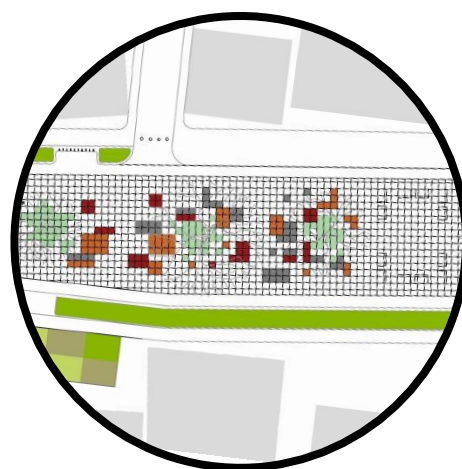


PROPOSED PLAN OF THE STREET

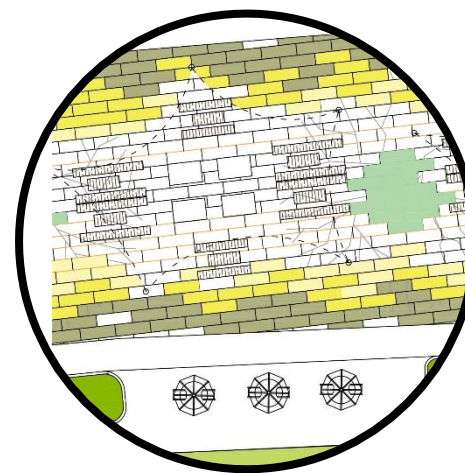
Green pathways connecting the residential neighbor hoods.



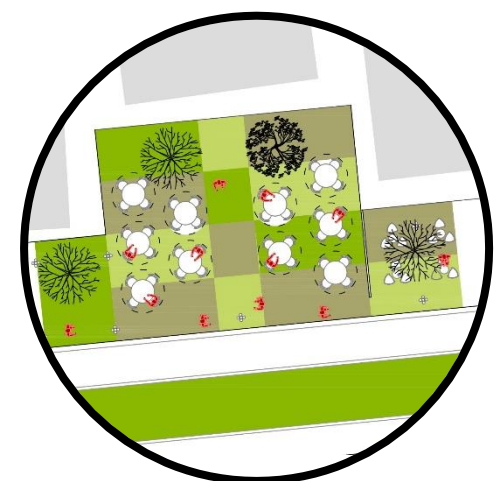
Open air gathering space and the foot over bridge that connects the street to the lake side.



Kids seating and play area.

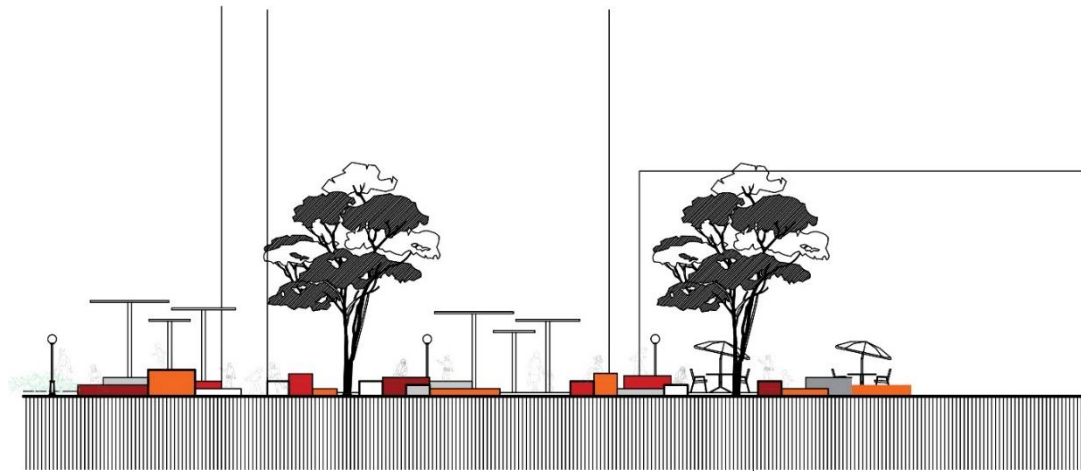

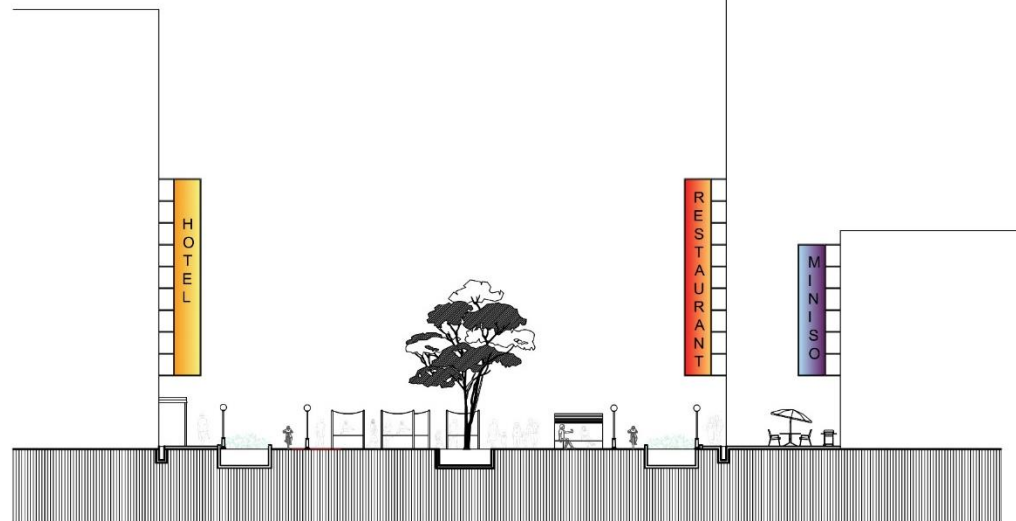

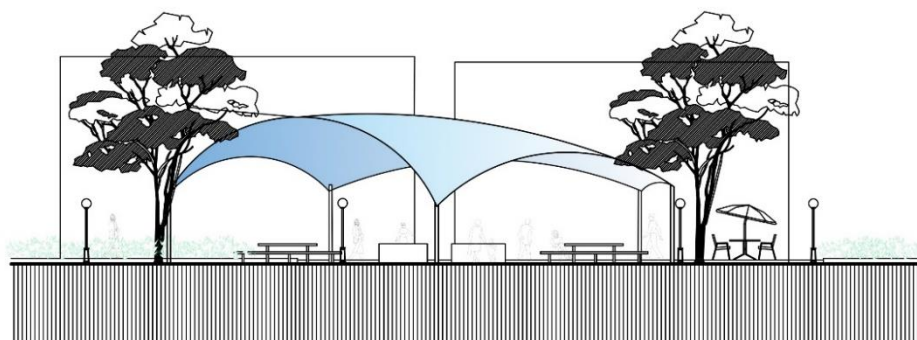

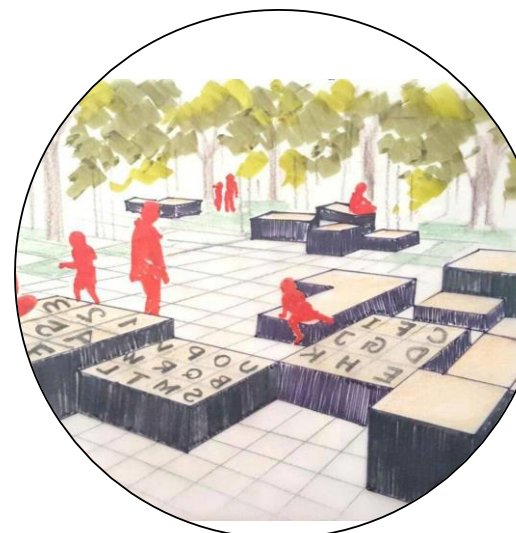
