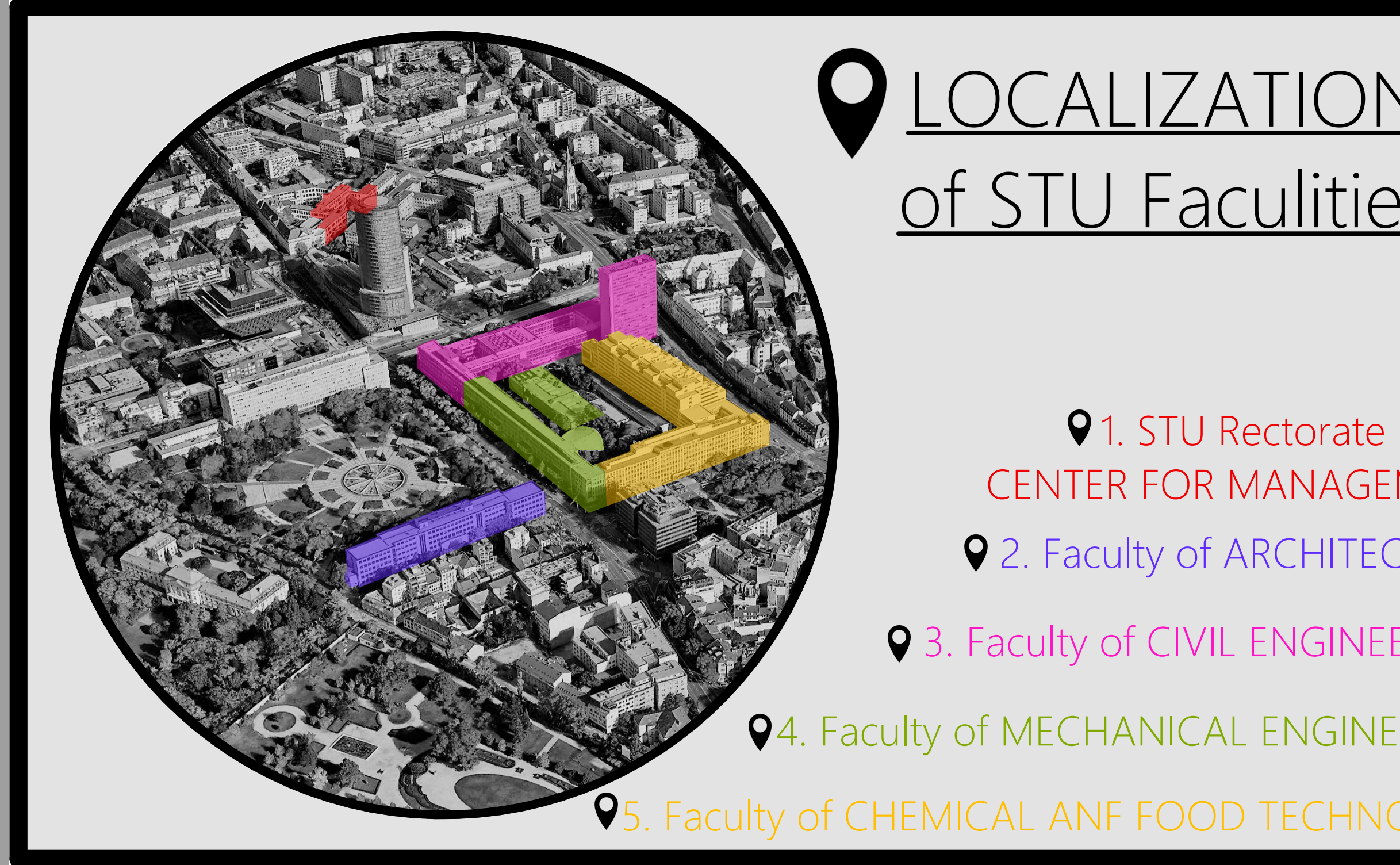


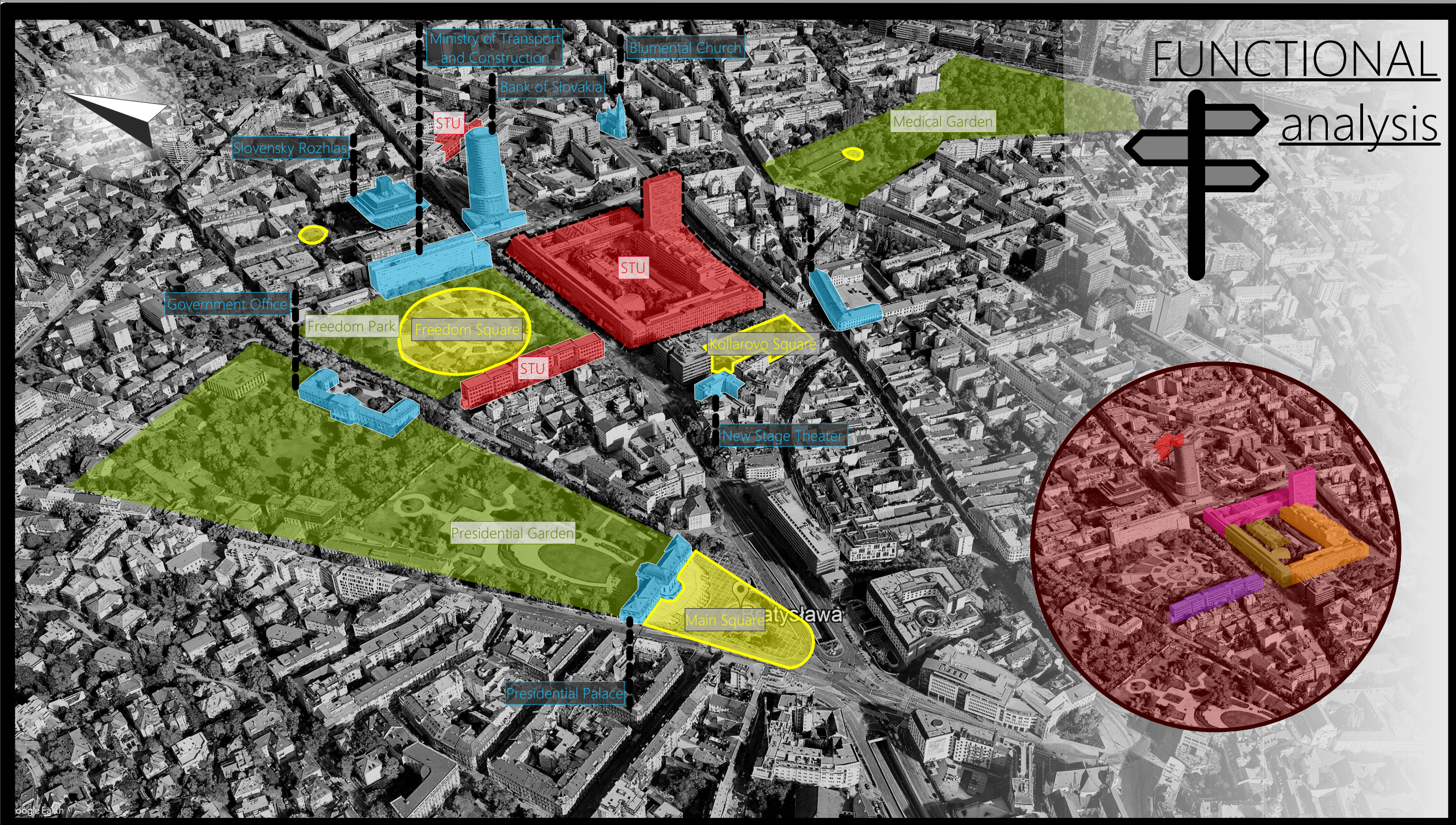
CONCEPTUAL DESIGN - CAMPUS



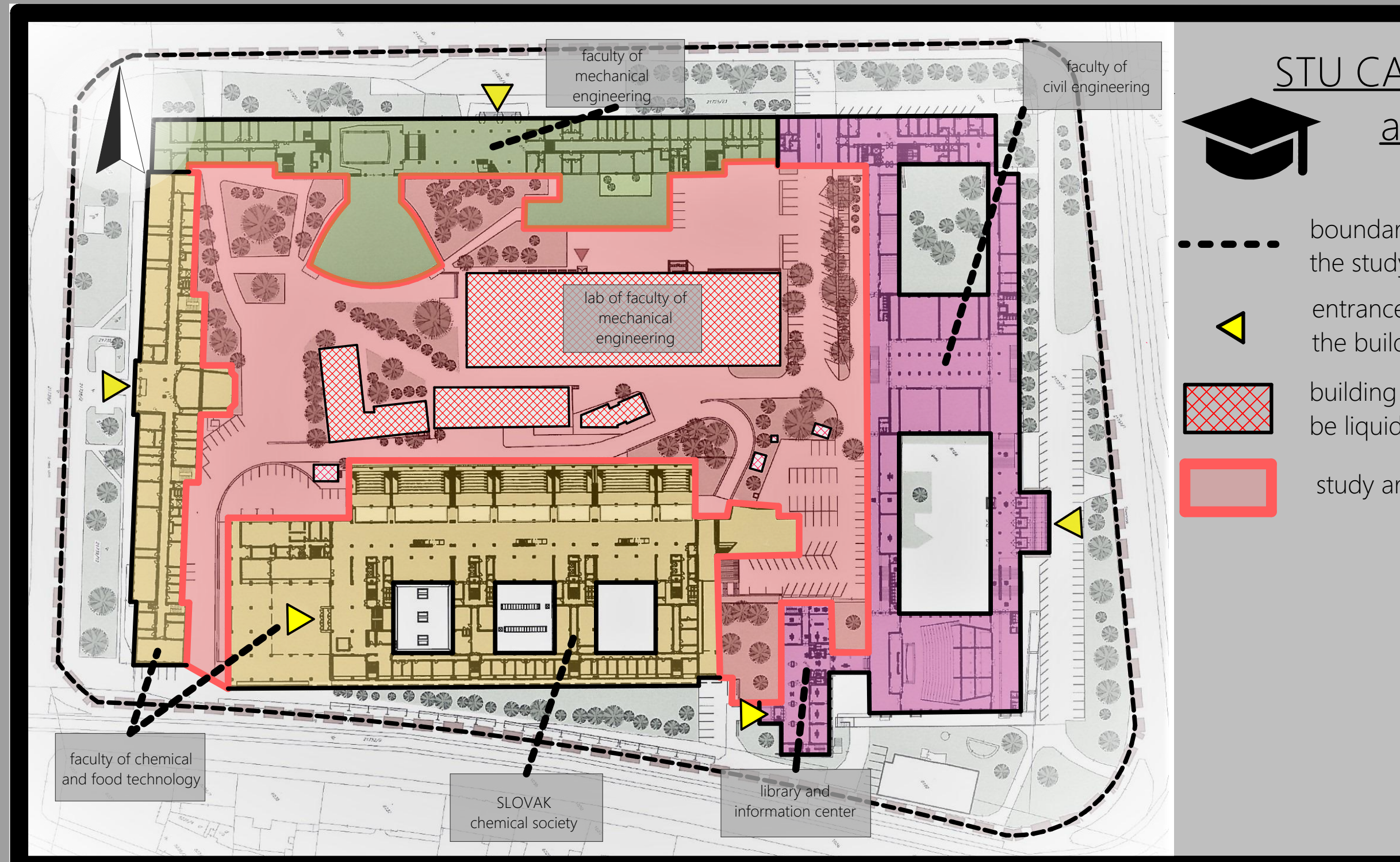
- the study site is located in Central Europe
- the city of Bratislava is located in south-east Slovakia



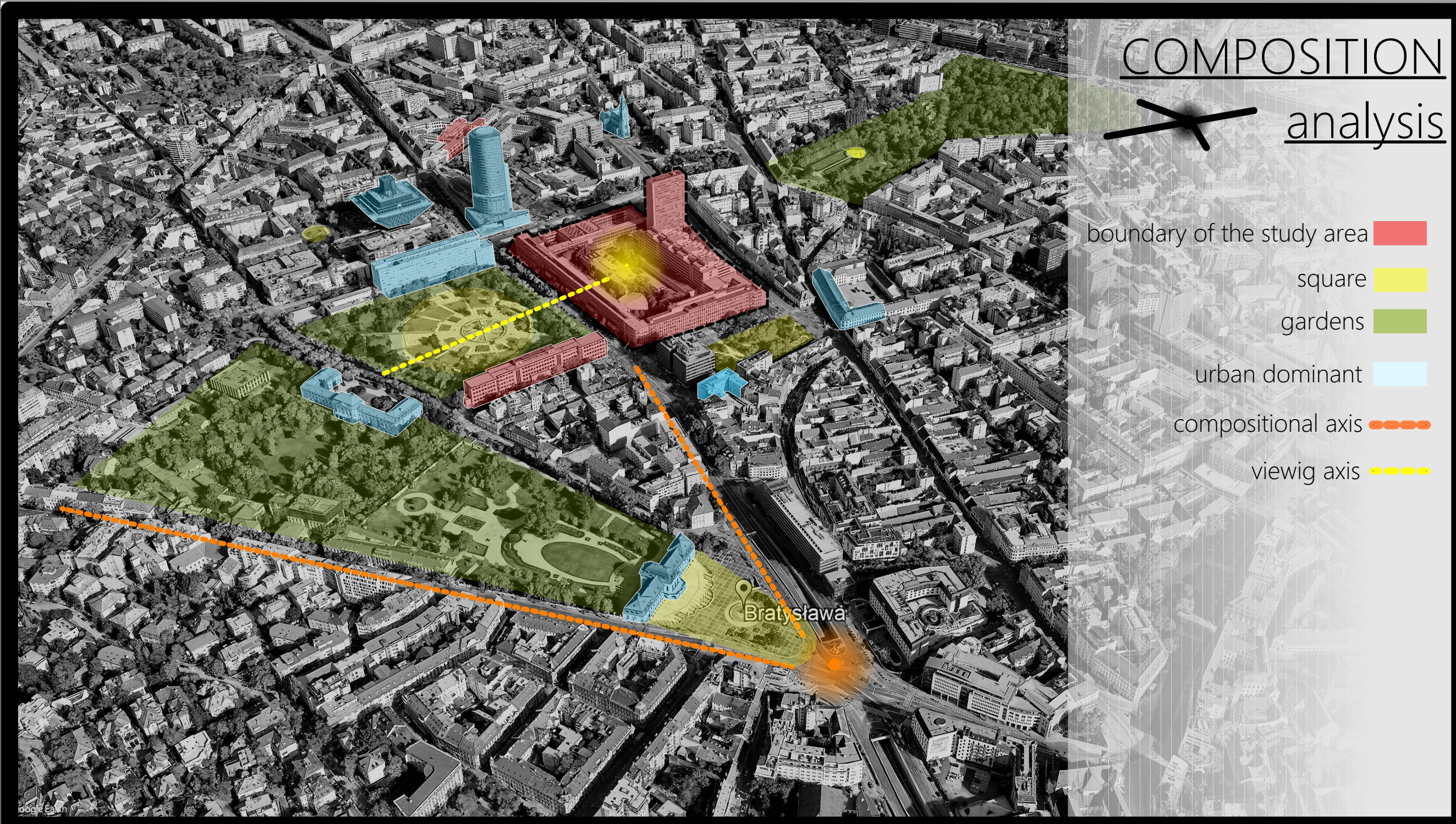
- the architectural department is not located on the premises main campus
- the rector's office building is located far from the main building campus
- the department of architecture and the main campus make up the western part of the campus



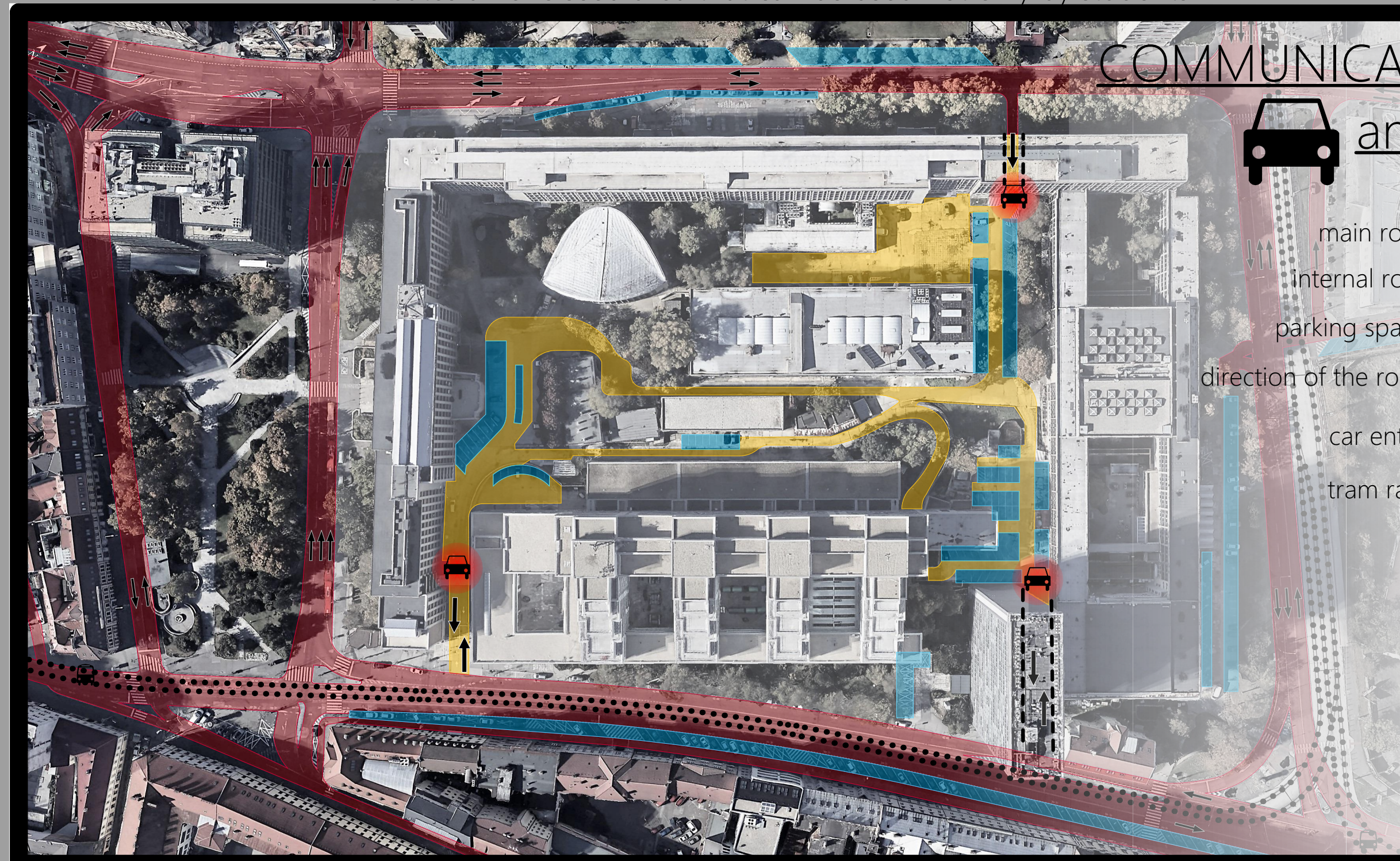
- there are many public institutions around the campus
- the campus is adjacent to parks, green areas and other public spaces
- there are no direct links between spaces public areas and the campus courtyard



- there are buildings to be demolished on the campus
- the campus courtyard should be a meeting place for the integration of students from nearby faculties
- the courtyard should have an underground car park
- the courtyard creates an enclosed area that can be used not only by students



- one of the main viewing axes is on Freedom Square
- campus courtyard should be connected to Liberty Square
- The Main Square is a center-forming place



- the campus has sufficient (3) car entries on the campus
- campus area has poorly planned communication which needs to be changed
- there are few parking spaces on campus



- there are no designated bicycle paths in the vicinity of the STU
- no combination of parks and urban spaces
- the campus is surrounded by parks and gardens, which are not used for student recreation places
- there is a lack of recreational greenery inside the campus
