FORM EVOLUTION



1 CAMERA

The circular opening represents the focus on nature and view.



2 SUBTRACTING

Subtraction creates a framed view and semi-open space.



3 SPLIT BUILDING FORM

The form is split into two volumes to create entry and functional zones.



4 LENS

Lens elements inspire the curved facade and circular opening.



5 CURVED BALCONIES

Curved balconies echo the lens form and soften the facade.



6 ROUND PROJECTED WINDOW

A prominent round projected window becomes the identity element of the cottage.

Creating levels to add visual interest and better views.



Final mass with split volumes and level variation.

KEY DESIGN FEATURES

-  Circular opening as a visual focus and identity.
-  Curved balconies for views and aesthetics.
-  Split volumes for functional zoning and privacy.

-  Prominent round projected window as a signature element.

CONCEPT SUMMARY

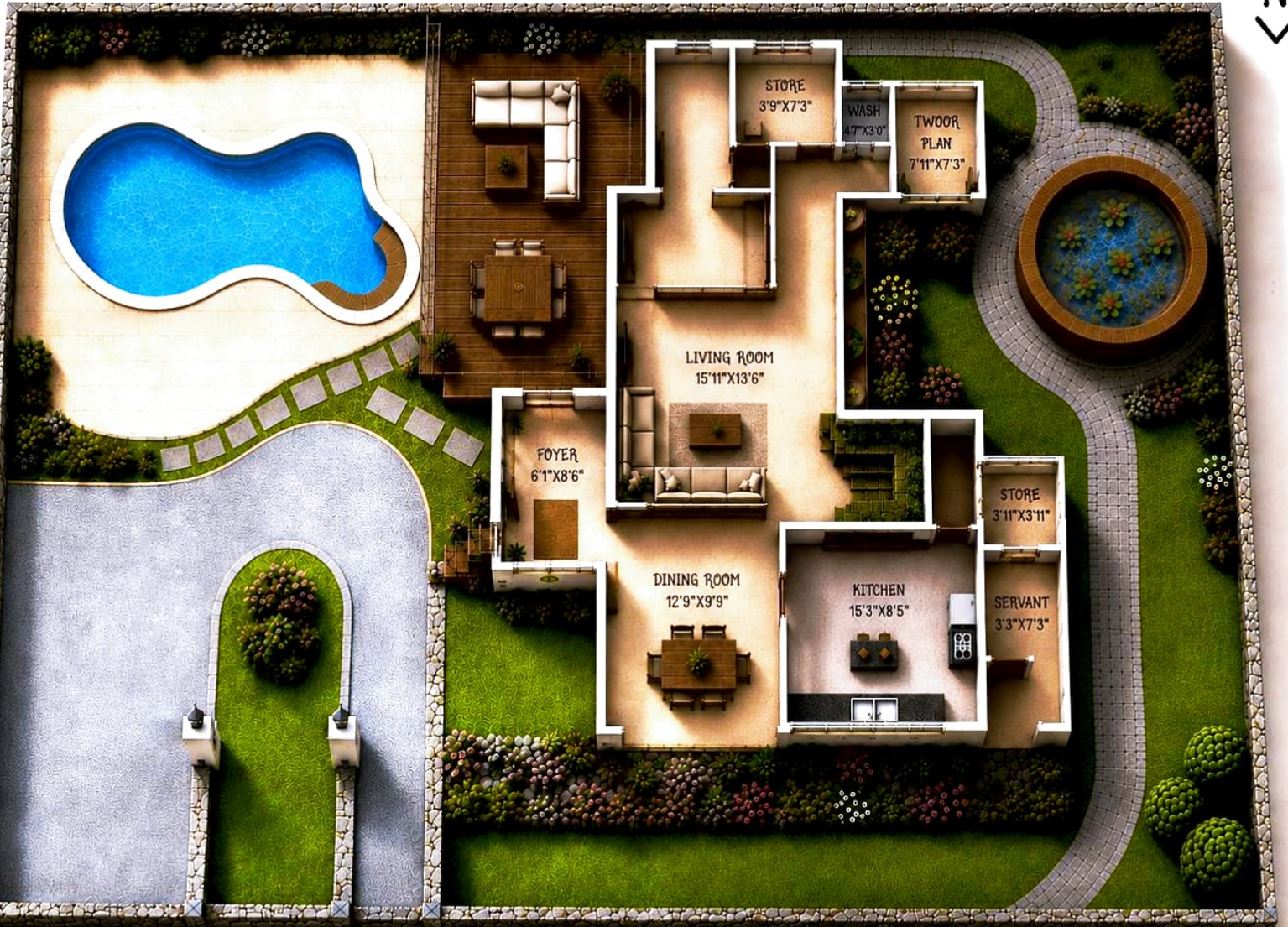
