



# BROKIS Recreation area with accomodation

**The aim of the project** was the comprehensive reconstruction of the Brokis glassworks campus in Janštejn. Our six-member team developed an urban masterplan ensuring seamless spatial connectors across the site, which integrates new facilities including headquarters, an educational center, a museum, and accommodations. My specific focus is transforming an unused sports hall and its decaying football field into a vibrant recreation center. The site is envisioned as a tranquil nature retreat, offering high-quality facilities for youth sports camps, corporate teambuilding, and workshop participants.

**The architectural concept** involves replacing the original large football field with a contemporary timber accommodation structure. This new wooden volume is visually linked to the existing concrete sports hall through prominent vertical elements and the strategic use of stainless steel details and integrated greenery, creating a cohesive dialogue with the wider Brokis campus. The dominant feature of the accommodation is a central sculptural staircase. Unambiguously, the area is carefully divided into specific zones to screen less pleasant views and ensure maximum privacy for the users. A unifying pathway connects these zones, guiding visitors from the main entrance, through a central courtyard, directly to the dedicated sports and relaxation areas.
