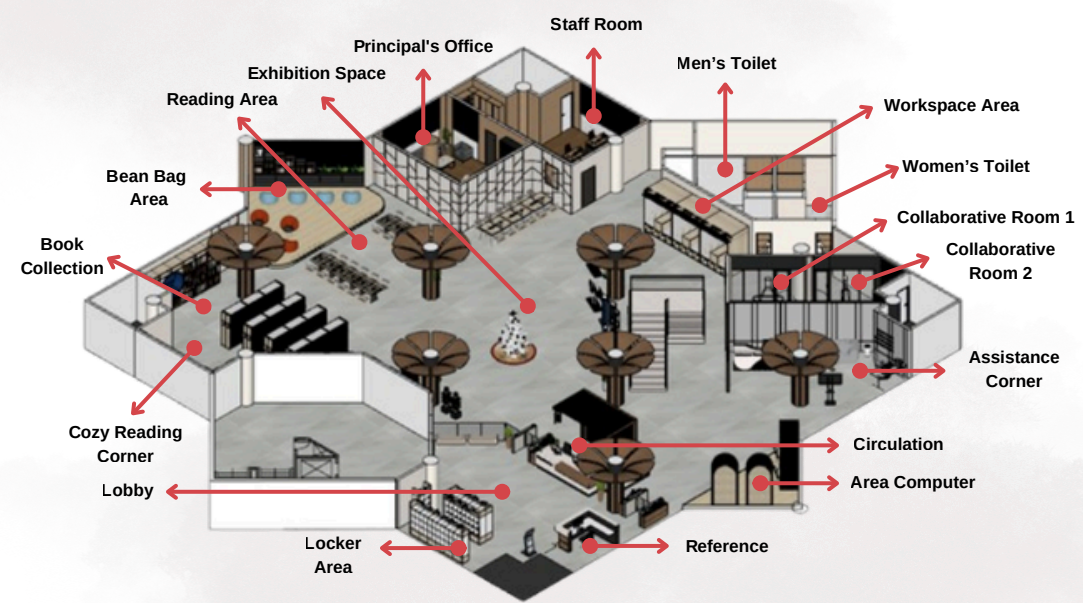
DESIGN CONCEPT

Alba Ligno, derived from **alba** (light) and **ligno** (wood). Reimagines the 6th Floor Library of Petra Christian University as a contemporary sanctuary for learning and reflection. Rooted in **Scandinavian** and **Modern Minimalist** principles, the design embraces natural light, soft neutral tones, and warm wood textures to create a calm, bright, and welcoming atmosphere.

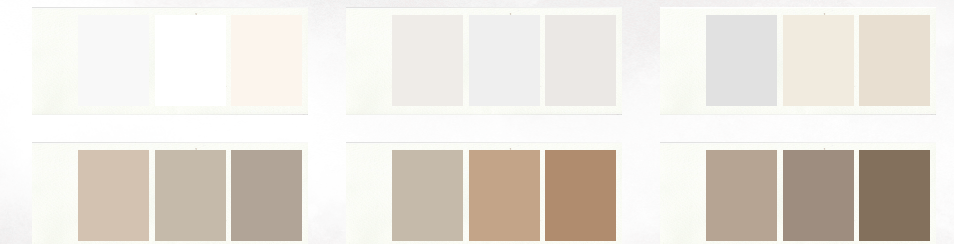

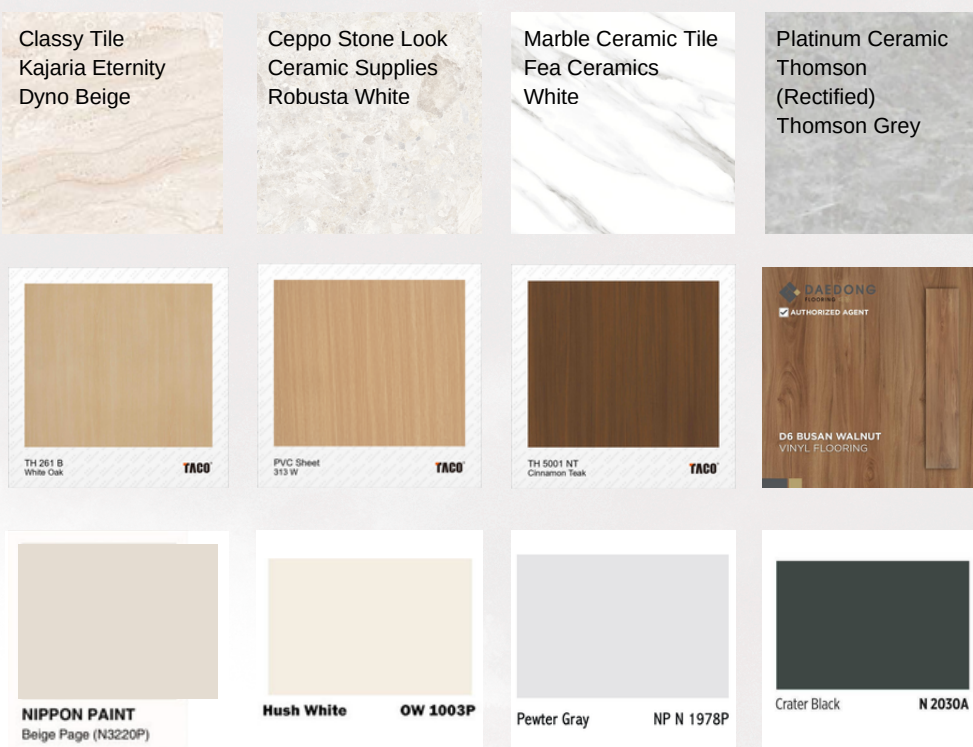
