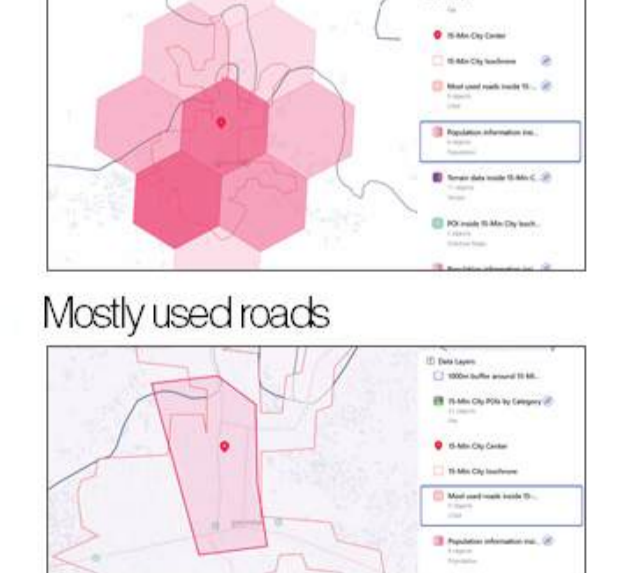
Heat map showing the most active zones in the site
