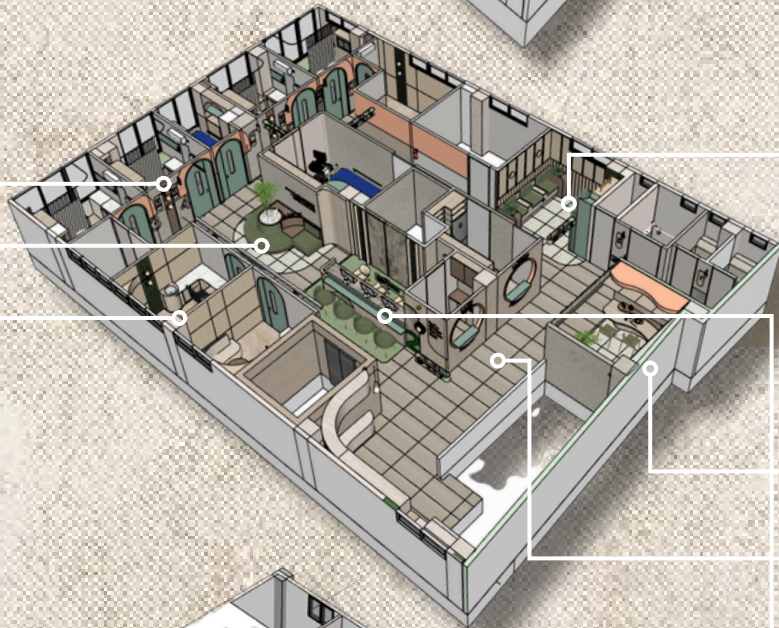

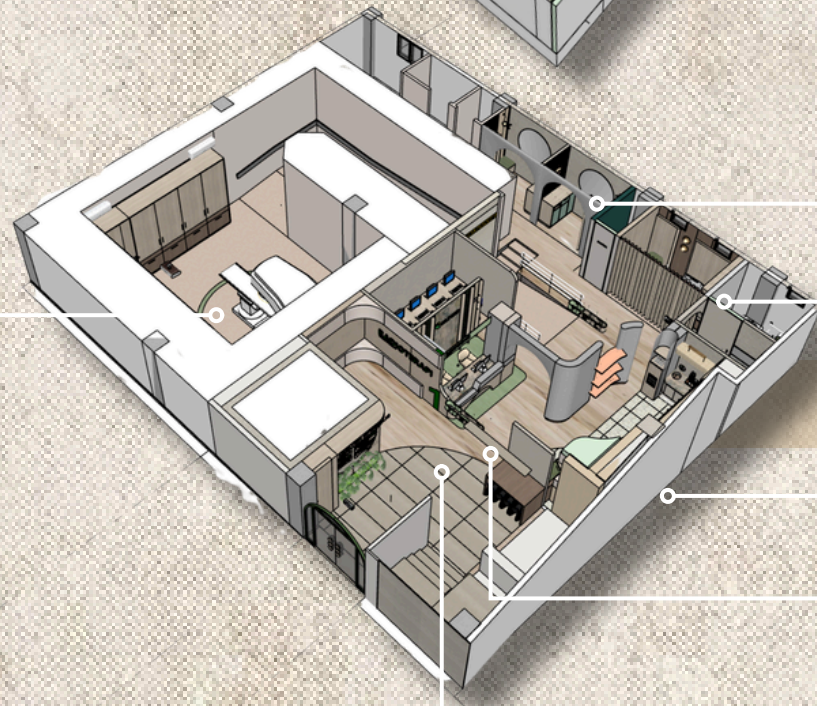

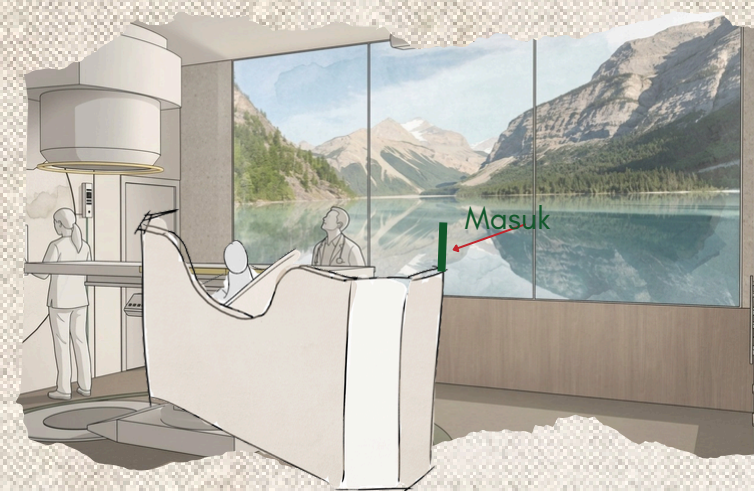


Natural lighting can reduce tension before therapy and provide a rounded shadow effect that can add to the aesthetics.

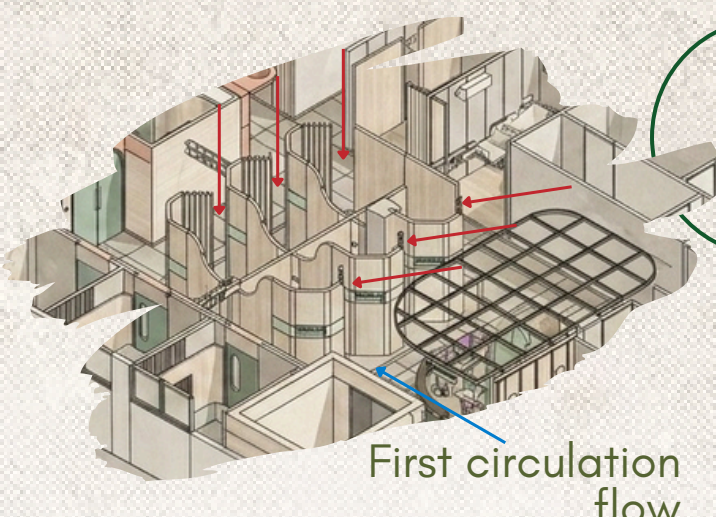
Sunlight enters through a circular shape that is given satin (opaque) glass so it is not as hot as clear pure glass.



Users can do funny activities such as drawing, making origami or writing quotes that can be displayed on a corkboard, so that users feel noticed and encouraged.



Ultra short throw projector that reflects images on the wall (stretch wall) makes the room feel more spacious and not tense



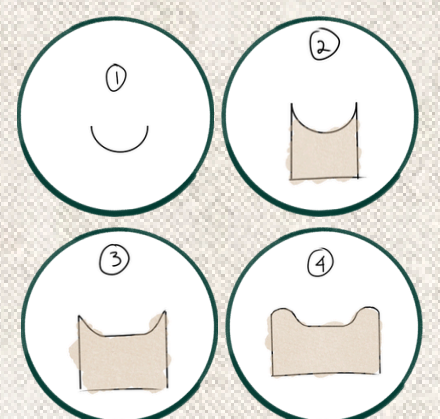
First circulation flow

The stylized results of the curved or arc shape give the impression of hugging a patient undergoing chemotherapy.

- The entrance to this area is angled and at the back, so that other users passing through the reception area or waiting area are not directly visible from the front (direct spotlights).
- This facilitates patient monitoring by nurses and doctors.
