



MO'OY GAR

Space of Making

Within the cultural center, Mo'oy Gar is a women's basketry maker's space in Toronto where craft and everyday life coexist within a shared interior environment. The space is anchored by stepped, carpeted seating inspired by the traditional Gidir Gar, reinterpreted as a collaborative setting for collective making and gathering. Along the walls, recessed niches draw from the spatial logic of the Harari Gidir Gar, holding both raw materials and finished baskets to reveal the continuity of the craft process. Together, these elements establish a living environment where Harari basketry traditions are sustained through intergenerational exchange and shared making.
